Home and Community Care Transport Services

Home and Community Care

Southside Community Services' Home and Community Care (HACC) Program is jointly funded by the Commonwealth and ACT governments to provide services to assist older people and younger people with a disability and their Carers.



HACC offers many services including Special Care Transport, Centre Based

Day Care (CBDC), Case Management and a Volunteer Program.

Special Care Transport services are designed to assist eligible clients to access medical appointments, day care, therapeutic groups and assistance with shopping.

TRANSPORT SERVICES

HACC Special Care Transport Services are provided for clients who are:

- a frail older person
- a young person with a disability
- unable to use public transport
- able to be transferred from your wheelchair to the special care vehicle
- live in the Inner South area of Canberra

Eligibility

In order to determine if you are eligible for the service we need to collect some information from you. All information we collect is kept confidential.

Bookings

If you are eligible for the service you can then make bookings for transport by phoning the Transport Manager.

All bookings need to be made in advance and are prioritized according to need. If demand for the service on a particular day is high we may not be able to assist.

If you need to cancel your booking please phone the Transport Manager as soon as possible so that the service can be made available for other people.

Cost

There is a small fee for some of the services offered through the HACC Program. Those who are financially disadvantaged will not have their services refused or withdrawn for that reason.
